HARVEST DATE

The cool growing season and relatively dry October allowed for significant hang-time with harvest taking place at our flagship estate vineyard on November 4th and 5th.

WINEMAKING

Whole Cluster: Field sorted and fermented 100% whole cluster

Cold Soak: Average of 5 days pre-fermentation maceration

Fermentation: Average of 20 days

Total Skin Contact: Average of 25 days

Barrel Aging: 16 months in French oak barrels (13% new)

Bottling Date: February 28, 2013
