Warm growing conditions throughout the summer came to an abrupt end the last week of September when the valley was hit by a major storm that brought rain and cooler temperatures. Located at over 800' elevation, Guillen is historically a later ripening site. Because of this, the fruit preserved its integrity despite the heavy rains and optimal botrytis conditions. Because the fruit remained in such pristine condition, we let it hang for several days after the rains stopped. The fruit not only dried, but continued to ripen reaching optimal maturity. We harvested on October 6th and were rewarded with mature, clean, flavorful fruit. Yields at harvest were 2.15 tons per acre.
